- *Please provide information on other individuals you wish to be part of the procession, including placement
- *For an 11:00AM wedding; you have church access starting at 10:00AM through 12:30PM; *For a 1:30PM wedding you have church access starting at 12:30PM through 3:00PM
- *Bride and Maids will congregate in the north corner of the church vestibule. This area will be sectioned off from the rest of the vestibule area for privacy.
- *Groom and groomsmen will congregate in the sacristy at the front of the church, just off the altar area
- *Everyone in the procession MUST be in the church vestibule 15 minutes prior to the wedding start
- *Procession starts promptly at 10:55AM or 1:25PM this is when non-bridal party members enter church (i.e. grandparents, parents)
- *Ushers are a vital part of the wedding. We request their assistance in the vestibule during the procession in to the church
- *Rehearsal: Please enter the church through the side door on the parking lot side of the church. This doorway had a ramp and a set of stairs leading to it. Please have members of the wedding party, the readers, ministers, ushers and anyone else who will be in the wedding procession attend the rehearsal. 45 minutes; promptness is appreciated due to there being more than one rehearsal in the same evening.
